valuecultural awareness

This term we will be covering cultural awareness through the module: **The Promise**

Main Topics Sessions 1-4

As the year begins, we'll be exploring the first part of the Bible, discovering God's plan & promise for the world, & how He used ordinary people for extraordinary purposes. The Bible is full of twists and turns & unexpected situations, & through it all a message of hope shines through.

Conversation Starters

- 1 Have you ever met someone who you thought was ordinary, but then discovered they have done something really amazing in their life?
- 2 Do you have a special skill or talent that you hope one day you'll be able to use to make a difference in the world?

Main Topics Sessions 5-7

In the second part of this module students will learn more about the person of Jesus & understand why His life was so significant. They'll also understand more about what Christians celebrate at Easter; the events that led up to Jesus' death, & what happened on the day His tomb was discovered empty.

Conversation Starters

- 1 What do you already know about the Biblical story of Easter? How would you tell the story?
- 2 Why do you think Jesus is such a significant person in history? What makes Him stand out from the rest?
